- 三、每一份報名表限投稿一篇作品。

柒、 評選方式:

- 一、潾選作品40名。
- 二、評分標準:主題表現(40%)、創意(30%)、照片(30%)。
- 三、審查:由主辦單位邀聘評選委員進行評分。
- 四、入選作品將於評審作業完成後,擇日公告於網頁並用電子郵件通知入選者,未獲入選者將不另行通知。
- 捌、 獎勵辦法:凡符合投稿內容規定,且經作品錄取者將給予稿酬 1000 元及文 集一本。

玖、 注意事項:

Taiwan Hostfamily Program An Invitation to Share Your Story

- I. Event Purpose: This essay contest has been designed to encourage an exchange of hostfamily memories and experiences via the written word and photographs. The contest is open to all international students, hostfamilies, school staff, and Taiwanese students who have participated in the Taiwan Hostfamily Program in the past.
- II. Event Sponsor: Taiwan's Ministry of Education
- III. Event Coordinator: Taiwan Hostfamily Program Office (Southern Taiwan University of Technology)
- IV. Deadline for Essay Submissions: Oct. 18, 2011

V. Writing Content:

- 1. Whether you were the Taiwanese host or were hosted by a family in Taiwan, we welcome you to write about your experience.
- 2. We welcome all writing styles and genres, as long as the word count ranges from 300-600 words in either English or Chinese. At least 5 photos (as .jpg files if submission is emailed) should be included along with your written submission. There are no limits to the number of stories you may submit.

VI. How to Submit Your Story:

- 1. Please download Application Guidelines, a Submission Form, and a Copyright Transfer Agreement all available at: http://www.hostfamily.org.tw.
- 2. Please send your Submission Form, Copyright Transfer Agreement, written story, and photos to the address or email below. Please mark the envelope or title the email with "Taiwan Hostfamily Program: Share Your Story Contest."
- 3. Each story you submit must have its own Submission Form and Copyright Transfer Agreement, and be mailed separately.

VII. Evaluation Process:

- 1. 40 stories will be selected.
- 2. These will be selected based on: Presentation (40%), Creativity (30%), and Photos (30%).
- 3. The event sponsor will select a judging panel to evaluate all entries.
- 4. Essays that are selected will be posted on our website. Candidates that are nominated will be notified by email. Those who aren't nominated will not be informed.
- VIII. Awards: For each story selected the author will receive a cash award of NT\$1,000 and a book.

IX. Notes:

- 1. The event sponsor reserves the right to edit to all submitted works. If you don't want your work to be edited, please notify us when you submit your story.
- 2. If the entry submitted by the applicant is found to contain the following, the sponsor reserves the right to nullify the participant's work, demand an award refund, and prosecute:
 - a. The writing has already been published or submitted for a prior event.
 - b. The writing or photos have been plagiarized, forged, or fake or obtained in any illegal manner.
- 3. The event organizer reserves the right to cancel, halt, or make changes to this contest.
- 4. The winners of this contest must agree to give the MOE and the event sponsor all rights to their submitted stories and photos without remuneration.
- 5. By participating in this event, the applicant agrees to submit to all decisions made by the judging panel. The work and photos submitted for this event will NOT be returned; hence, the applicant must keep a copy of his/her work or photos if necessary. If any applicant is found to have infringed on any regulations pertaining to this event, the event sponsor reserves the right to cancel the applicant's eligibility.
- 6. The event sponsor reserves the right to change how this event is held at any time. Changes will be posted on its website without further notice.
