

2011 DR GOH KENG SWEE (GKS) SCHOLARSHIP BRIEF

ABOUT THE DR GKS SCHOLARSHIP

The Dr Goh Keng Swee (GKS) Scholarship Fund was set up by the financial community in Singapore in honour of the late Deputy Prime Minister, who fostered Singapore's economic development and growth as a reputable international financial centre. The Dr GKS Scholarship is a private sector scholarship administered by the Association of Banks in Singapore (ABS). Each year, 3 to 4 scholarships are awarded to outstanding individuals from 15 Asia Pacific economies¹ to pursue undergraduate studies at local universities in Singapore (i.e., National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technological University and Singapore Management University). The course of study should preferably be relevant to the financial sector.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Dr GKS Scholarship is highly selective. Applicants should fulfil the following criteria:

- (a) Concurrently apply for admission to NUS, NTU or SMU for their course of study. Applicants should adhere to the university's admission deadlines and guidelines;
- (b) Demonstrate leadership qualities and possess good co-curricular activities (CCA) records;
- (c) Be a citizen/passport holder of the target Asia Pacific economies;
- (d) Make private arrangements to sit for the required university admission tests (e.g., SAT and TOEFL), and
- (e) Preferably be below 25 years of age.

DURATION & TERMS OF AWARD

The scholarship will support a maximum of 4 years of undergraduate study (includes Honours). It provides the following:

- (a) Tuition and other compulsory fees;
- (b) Airfare (to Singapore and return to home country upon completion of study);
- (c) Annual maintenance allowance of SGD\$6500;
- (d) Hostel allowance based on institution of study; and
- (e) Settling-in allowance (one-off expense) of SGD\$200 upon arrival in Singapore.

The scholarship award will be reviewed annually and is subjected to satisfactory performance and academic results.

¹ The 15 Asia Pacific economies are Brunei, Cambodia, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, PRC, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam.

BOND

Successful candidates will be required to work for 3 years upon the completion of their studies in either:

- (a) An approved company in Singapore; or
- (b) An approved Singapore-based company in their home country.

The deployment of scholars to serve their bonds will be determined by the Dr Goh Keng Swee Scholarship Fund.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Applicants should submit the following documents together with the scholarship application form:

- (a) High school examination results;
- (b) GCE 'O' and 'A' level examination results or equivalent qualifications (if any);
- (c) Results of examinations taken thus far in university (applicable for existing undergraduate applicants);
- (d) Results of Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) or Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), if these tests are necessary for admission into local universities;
- (e) Detailed records of co-curricular activities at pre-university and university level (if applicable); and
- (f) A written essay of not more than 500 words.

If the above supporting documents are not available at the time of submission, please indicate when they will be available.

DATES OF APPLICATION

The 2011 Dr GKS Scholarship application will commence on **30 Nov 2010** and end on **17 Jan 2011**.

Please submit the completed application form and supporting documents to the Singapore Embassy/High Commission in your place of residence. Refer to **Annex A** for the addresses of the various Singapore Embassy/High Commission.

Shortlisted applicants are required to travel to Singapore for psychometric assessment tests and interview in May 2011 at their own expense.
